# Brief Background

---

- Immersion programme was initiated from the MTL Review done in the year 2007
- STB has worked with Teacher Training Centre of Indonesia for the Immersion Programme this year



# Objectives of the Immersion Programme

---

- To deepen the participants' knowledge of the Malay Language (ML )
- To create opportunities for participants to have a teaching practice in Malaysian schools



# Objectives of the Immersion Programme

---

- To enhance participants' understanding of Malay Culture
- To learn and apply different pedagogies in the teaching of the Malay Language



# Programme Content

- 4 days of Lectures
- 2 days of School Visits
- 6 days of School Attachment
- 4 days of Cultural Visits



# Lectures :

- Principles of Language Teaching Methods
- Techniques of Language Teaching and Learning
- Assessment of Language Learning
- Materials Development



# School Visits :

---

- 4 Schools



# School Attachment

---

- Each teacher will be based in one school for 6 days
- Teachers will observe and co-teach
- Teachers will be attached to schools in groups of threes/fours
